Jesus and the Christian Life from Luke's perspective

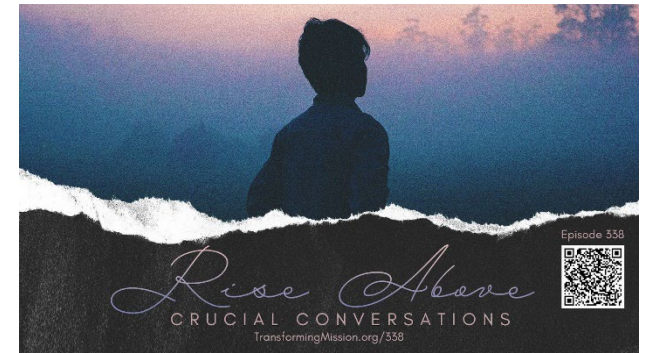
October 6: John 14:1-9
