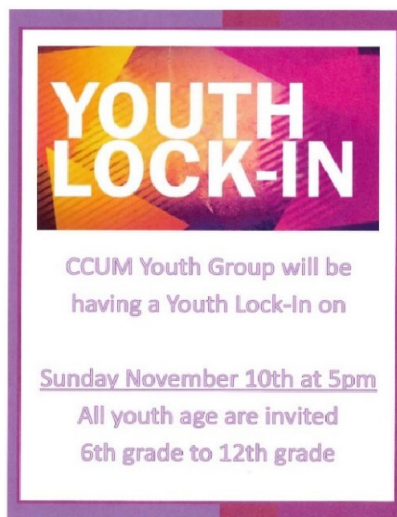

In March 1933, Franklin D. Roosevelt became President of the United States of America. He is known for many initiatives and accomplishments as president, but one line in his first inaugural address defined who he was as a leader, “the only thing we have to fear is fear itself.”

He was in effect calling the nation to action. He said fear was “nameless, unreasoning, unjustified terror which paralyzes needed efforts to convert retreat into advance.” What he told the people was that the only barrier to progress was the fear of facing the real challenges and that once the fear had been faced the road to recovery would be open. 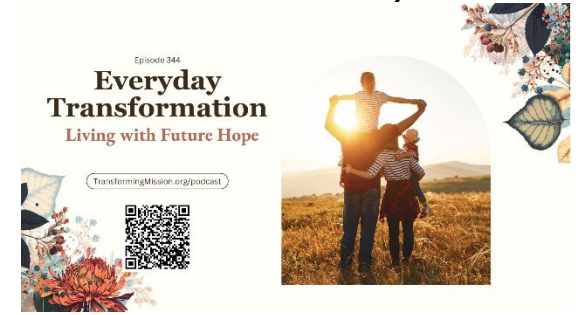
### November 3: Matthew 28:20 - Engaging the Community
